Users should also note that some web-resources such as Google Scholar™ do automatic reads of the GSB site and thus the requested information in a search will not necessarily appear as a top “hit”. Authors are requested to better inform themselves of the criteria required for a journal to be included on a data-base of choice before making a request for inclusion on that data-base, e.g. regularity of publication, minimum number of years of publication, etc.

A link to the GSB site must also be provided.
